



{Purpose of the Learning Passport}

The Master Program in Artificial Intelligence Applications and Management encourages the active students to participate in both the activities related to AI learning/study/researches and the activities with international nature exploring Taiwan culture/places. Students will gain the points of the passport after participations in the activities recognized by the Program.

The points requirement for graduation are 6 points.

Refer to the following for the points earning criteria for each activity,

1	Industrial/Cultural/Business Visits Participation Visits organized by AIAM program, other programs in ICSI, ICSI or other NTPU units/offices with the similar natures mentioned above could be counted. *Required supplement: a short feedback report with at least 200 words.	One (1) point per participation
2	On/Off Campus AI Competitions Participation The topic of the competitions shall be related to AI applications/management while the team is formed of students of different nationalities. *Required supplement: certificate for participation/award.	Three (3) points per competition Additional three (3) points for each award received
3	On/Off Campus non-AI Competitions Participation Participating in other on/off campus competitions in teams formed of students of different nationalities *Required supplement: certificate for	Two (2) points per competition Additional one (1) point for each award received

4	The Presentation in the AI related International Conference *Required supplement: certificate for presentation and participation.	Six (6) points per conference and presentation
5	The Participation in the AIAM Annual Academic Sharing Event Joining the annually AIAM academic presentation event (usually in the Spring semester)	One (1) point per participation
6	The Participation in Student Buddy Program Participating in the student buddy program held by the Program	One (1) point per semester
7	Joining in Local Public-Good Events, Volunteering or Cultural Ambassadors Events *Required supplement: Certificate issued by the organization	One (1) point per participation
8	Joining the Exchange or Dual-degree Program in an Overseas Sister School	Three (3) points per participation
9	Get a Foreign Language Competence Exam Certificate Taking the non-native language competence exams held by official/world recognized organizations *Required supplement: The certificate	One (1) point per participation
